SUBJECT: ACT College and Career Readiness Workshop

The Assessment Section, in conjunction with ACT, will be conducting a one-day workshop for high school principals (or designees), ACT test coordinators, college counselors and complex area staff members on Wednesday, August 28, 2019 at the Diamond Head Annex, Room 226 (475 22nd Avenue). Public and public charter school personnel who have a role in coordinating or administering the ACT College and Career Readiness system of assessments are invited to attend this workshop. Important information will be shared about The ACT, PreACT and WorkKeys.

The purpose of the ACT College and Career Readiness Workshop is to provide participants with the necessary information to plan, administer and interpret the results of any of the optional suite of ACT assessments and to assist students in meeting their college and career goals.

Topics to be covered in the workshop include:

- School Year 2019-20 test windows for the ACT program assessments
- Information about the PreACT and WorkKeys assessments
- Scheduling tips and tricks for the PreACT and WorkKeys assessments
- Using score reports and results to assist students in setting and meeting college and career goals
- Using PreACT results to guide interventions
- Using WorkKeys assessments to gauge college and career readiness
- Hands-on demonstrations of available resources.
