## EOC Exams

### 6. EOC Exam Eligibility

Eligibility for the End-of-Course (EOC) exams will be set in [TIDE](#) for the fall testing window on *Tuesday, November 5, 2019*. Test coordinators should make sure that student information is updated in eCSSS for IDEA/504 and ELL students, and designated supports have been entered into TIDE. If accommodations are needed, submit the [Accommodations Verification Form](#) to the Assessment Section for verification of the student’s need. Test coordinators should also confirm with technology coordinators that the updated Secure Browser has been installed prior to the start of testing.

### 7. Mac OS 10.15 (Catalina) update and AIR Secure Browser

Earlier this month Apple released the updated Mac OS 10.15 (Catalina) operating system, which if installed on student Mac test devices, will cause the AIR Secure Browser to fail to launch. ***School TAs and/or Technology Coordinators should not update any Mac computers being used for testing until the AIR software review team has confirmed Mac OS 10.15 is compatible with AIR testing systems.*** Another announcement will be posted once compatibility has been confirmed.

## **8. Mac OS 10.15 (Catalina) update and ACCESS for ELLs Online Assessments**

DRC recommends that HIDOE schools using Mac computers as test devices for the ACCESS For ELLs Online test should not run the auto update to Mac OS 10.15 until thorough testing has been performed by DRC. Mac computers that have been updated to Catalina will display a yellow icon when running the System Readiness check to denote that this OS is in the process of being certified to work with INSIGHT and the COS software.
