## 6. Science Item Authoring Training

There will be a virtual training for science teachers to become item authors for the Hawaii Statewide Assessment Program (HSAP). Teachers who are interested in learning how test questions are developed and how alignment to the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) is ensured are encouraged to apply. Items being developed will be included in the Checkpoint system for use in developing standards-aligned, teacher generated tests. Participants will receive instruction on content and item/task specifications, practical training in developing assessment items for classroom use, and participate in collegial discussions of assessment targets based on the NGSS performance expectations. Applicants should have a good understanding of the NGSS for the grade level(s) taught.

There will be an orientation on Monday afternoon October 4, 2021 and the training will be October 11-14, 2021 from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. ## 9. Smarter Balanced Supported Operating Systems

Technology coordinators should refer to the <u>Cambium Operating System Support Plan for Test</u> <u>Delivery System 2021-2022</u> for a list of supported operating systems for the Smarter Balanced Secure Browser.

Please keep in mind that major upgrades to OS such as Mac OS 12 (Monterey) and Windows 11 have not yet been fully tested, so the test vendor recommends not installing these upgrades as they may have unintended consequences on the Secure Browsers.
