### 5. PANext Availability

[PearsonAccessNext](#) (PANext) will open on *November 1, 2021*, for the Spring 2022 administration of the ACT. Test coordinators should verify that they are able to access this site in order to perform the [Prepare for Testing](#) tasks in the [Schedule of Events](#) on the ACT Hawaii website. Test coordinators should ensure they have selected the Spring 2022 administration in PANext.

*Current school year juniors will not appear in PANext until mid-December after the students are loaded into PANext (the ACT is only to be administered to current 11th graders, as defined by credit count in Infinite Campus. Students who were administered the ACT on a statewide test date in a previous year should not be administered the test again, i.e., 11R students).*

### 7. iPad OS v14.x Settings for INSIGHT Secure Browser

Apple released an enhanced security feature called Intelligent Tracking Prevention (ITP). For states who utilize DRC INSIGHT, you will need to manually enable Cross-Website Tracking on each iPad testing device using an iPadOS level 14.X.
