General Information

1. Fall Testing Window

The Fall Testing Window opens on *Monday, November 22, 2021* and remains open until *Friday, December 17, 2021*. Grade 11 students in block-schedule high schools completing their instruction in English Language Arts and/or mathematics are eligible to be administered the respective Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBA) at this time. In addition, students completing Biology 1, Algebra 1, and/or Algebra 2 are eligible to be administered the corresponding End-of-Course (EOC) exam.

The 11th grade SBAs in ELA and Mathematics, and the Biology 1 EOC Exam are required. The Algebra 1 and 2 EOC Exams are optional.

2. Remote Test Administration Office Hour Webinar

On *Wednesday, November 17, 2:30 - 3:45 p.m.*, the Assessment Section will host an Office Hour webinar covering the *option* of remote test administration of the summative Smarter Balanced and NGSS Science Assessments. While it is recommended that all statewide summative assessments be administered in-person and on the school campus, the option of remote testing is allowed for special circumstances, such as schools with distance learning students whose parents insist that their child be administered the summative Smarter Balanced and NGSS Science Assessments, but for safety or other reasons, will not allow their child to test in-person and on campus. *The decision to allow remote testing is a school-level decision*. Remote test administration policy, guidelines, and procedures will be discussed at this office hour webinar.

5. PANext Availability

<u>PearsonAccessNext</u> (PANext) is now open for the Spring 2022 administration of the ACT. Test coordinators should verify that they are able to access this site in order to perform the <u>Prepare for Testing</u> tasks in the <u>Schedule of Events</u> on the ACT Hawaii website. Deadlines and due dates are also available on the Schedule of Events page. Test coordinators are encouraged to bookmark this page for quick reference. Test coordinators should ensure they have selected the **Spring 2022** administration in PANext.

Current school year juniors will not appear in PANext until mid-December after the students are loaded into PANext (the ACT is only to be administered to current 11th graders, as defined by credit count in Infinite Campus. Students who were administered the ACT on a statewide test date in a previous year should not be administered the test again, i.e., 11R students).

6. Accommodations Request Window

The window for submitting accommodations requests for the spring 2022 administration of the ACT opened on *September 13, 2021 and will close on January 7, 2022*. No new requests will be considered after January 7, 2022.
