## **General Information**

### 1. Hawai'i State Test Accommodation Guides

The purpose of the <u>Test Accommodation Guides</u> is to clarify policies regarding state test accommodations for school individualized education programs (IEP) or Section 504 Accommodations Plan (504) teams. The guides contain information regarding test constructs and documented evidence needed for state test accommodation verification. The guides offer guiding questions to help IEP/504 teams during their discussions and use their special education expertise requests for state testing. These guides, together with the <u>Crosswalk of Accessibility Features Across State Assessments in Hawai'i 2021-2022</u> and student information in eCSSS (IEPs/504 Plans, etc.), are the primary documents used by the Assessment Section to verify accommodation requests for students with IEPs/504 Plans to participate in statewide testing.

#### 2. Assistive Technology Manual and Braille Resources 2021-2022

The <u>Assistive Technology Manual</u> provides information on administering the Hawaii Smarter Balanced and other statewide assessments to students who will use assistive technologies to access their tests, including students who require the Braille accommodation. ### 4. 2021-22 HSA-Alt Test Administration Manual

The HSA-Alt Test Administration Manual (TAM) contains updated policies and procedures for this year's test, including a streamlined process for documenting accommodations. HSA-Alt Accommodations, except for the Paper/Pencil Test, can be set directly in TIDE by school test coordinators and HSA-Alt test administrators. ### 5. Online HSA-Alt Test Administrator Certification Course

The online HSA-Alt Test Administration Certification Course is required for all HSA-Alt Test Administrators (TAs). ### 6. Technology Readiness Check

Test coordinators should check to confirm that their schools are prepared for the Spring 2022 administration of the ACCESS for ELLs assessment by using the Central Office Services (COS) dashboard on the <u>DRC website</u> (login required). Technology coordinators may not have access to this dashboard and cannot use this to verify system readiness.

Content Hosting and Content Management should be enabled to allow the COS to cache test content. The COS Last Checkin should have a date associated with it.
